# Keep track of your progress!



£1,000

£1000 could go towards the daily cost of providing respite care for up to 6 children at our hospice

£750

£750 could pay for a nurse providing vital care and support for a child for one week

£500

£500 could pay for 5 stay and play sessions to help integrate new families into the hospice

£250

£250 could pay for specialist toys and equipment to help us enrich the lives of children we support
